Frequently Asked Questions

Tools-- It is not necessary to bring any tools. LHFH will provide every tool you need. If you have tools that you prefer using feel free to bring them, but please make sure to mark them with your name!

Clothing – Makes sure to wear clothes in which you can comfortably work. The only requirement is all volunteers must wear closed-toed shoes. Dress for the weather and the task for the day. Remember to bring sunscreen on sunny days!

Age limit—All volunteers must be at least 16 years of age; a 4-1 adult-teenager chaperone ratio is required for volunteers 16-17 years of age.

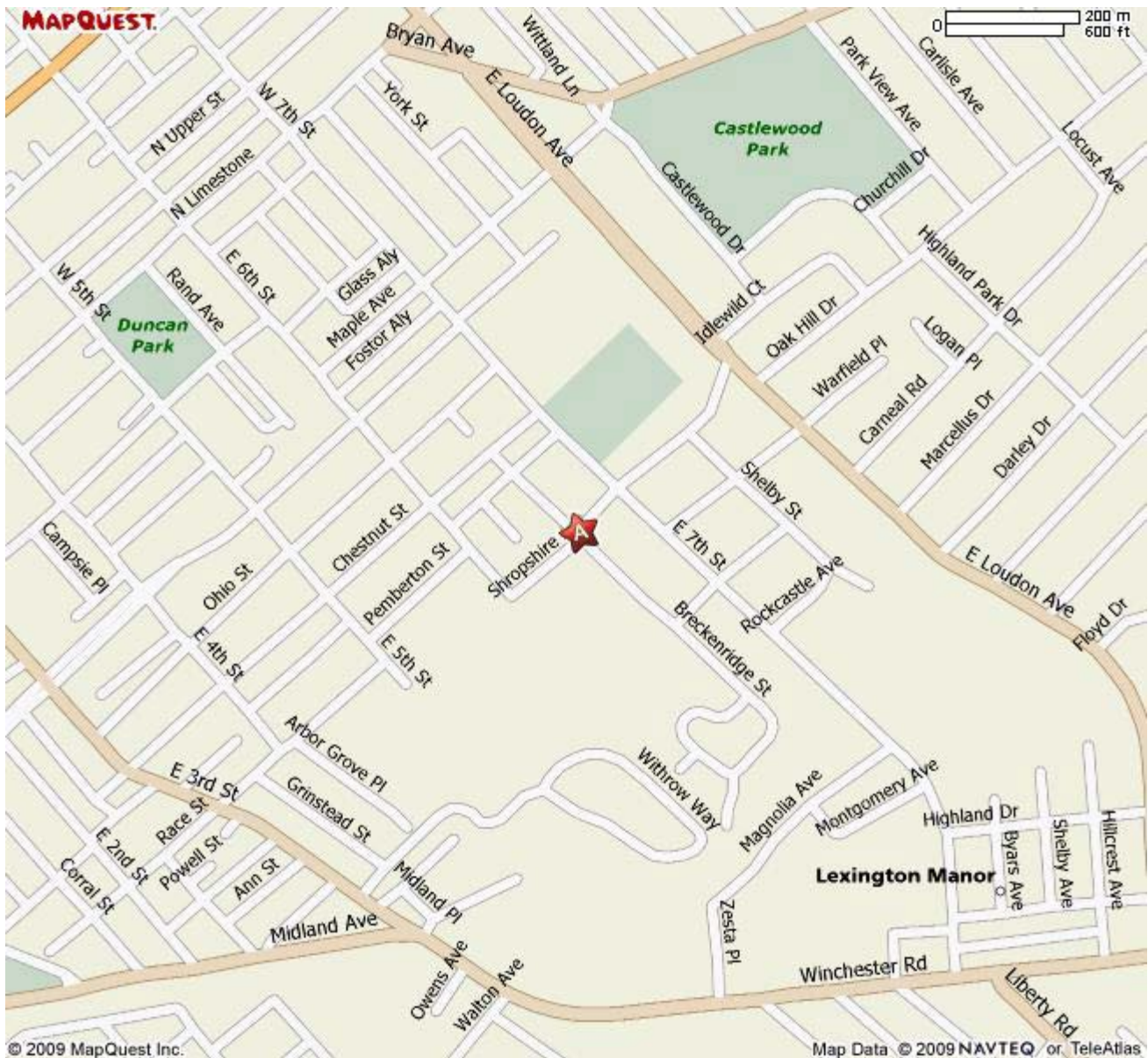
